15 *Low-maintenance love* The challenge in the NSW back garden was to create an easy-care entertaining space to suit homeowners Candy and Ryan's busy schedules. A Grand Hall 'GTS' barbecue from Masters and a handsome 'Kai 6' timber and wicker setting from Bay Gallery are an entertainer's dream. The 'India Grey' pavers (below) from Beaumont Tiles and Masters spotted gum decking are both practical and low maintenance.



17 *AU NATUREL* A combination of stone wall cladding - 'Alpine Mist' from Beaumont Tiles - and timber decking gives the front entrance a modern but restrained feel. Wrapping the support posts in the same spotted gum as the decking - all from Masters - restricts the palette, making the elegant front door the zone's main focus. The Urban Balcony 'Cemento' bench adds a dash of contemporary cool.



16 *FIRED UP* A fire pit from Aussie Heatwave Fireplaces and a 'Carolina' armchair from Bay Gallery come together to make the courtyard a must-sit spot. The 'Daisy Cluster' screen from Flower Power serves as an eye-catching focal point.



18 *Screen star* An abstract spotted gum timber screen, made from the same material as the front porch, cleverly creates a sense of privacy for the front door. Limestone 'Eclipse Flamed And Tumbled' pavers from Amber Tiles wend their way through the lawn, leading visitors to the door. The red brick exterior was rendered to tie in with the new modern look. **hb**
